RESOLUTION GRANTING REVOCABLE  
ENCROACHMENT PERMIT TO:

PACIFIC TELEPHONE COMPANY

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

That a revocable encroachment permit for the purpose of placing  
buried telephone cable is hereby granted to  
Pacific Telephone Company, whose address is as

The encroachment area is described as follows:

The area within a City-owned property located at the southeast corner of Florin-Perkins Road and Unsworth Avenue. The area, 6" in width by 145' in length, lying parallel to and 39' easterly of the center line of Florin-Perkins Road.

This permit is granted subject to the "General Provisions - Revocable Encroachment Permit" which were adopted by the City Council in Resolution No. 517, dated November 2, 1972, and the hereinafter specified special provisions, if any:
