SUMMARY:

This project will install a traffic signal and improvements at the intersection of 47th Avenue at Woodbine Avenue/Ventura Street. Improvements will include handicap ramps, pedestrian actuated signals, street lighting, and an interconnect system connecting the project traffic signal with the traffic signal at 47th Avenue and 24th Street.

Plans and specifications for the Traffic Signal and Improvements at 47th Avenue and Woodbine Avenue/Ventura Street project have been prepared. Approval of the plans and specifications and authorization to advertise for bids is recommended.

COMMITTEE/COMMISSION ACTION:

None.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

This project will install a traffic signal and improvements at the intersection of 47th Avenue at Woodbine Avenue/Ventura Street. Improvements will include handicap ramps, pedestrian actuated signals, street lighting, and an interconnect system connecting the project traffic signal with the traffic signal at 47th Avenue and 24th Street. The project will enhance public safety and improve traffic flow at this intersection.

A Categorical Exemption for the Traffic Signal and Improvements at 47th Avenue and Woodbine Avenue/Ventura Street project was filed with the County Clerk of the County of Sacramento on February 12, 1993.

FINANCIAL CONSIDERATIONS:

The engineer's estimated construction cost is \$100,500.

The estimated total project cost, including all planning, design and construction costs, is \$162,000. The current budget is \$166,500, which was approved in the 1992/93 Capital Improvement Program from the Gas Tax fund (202). The funds available for this project amount to \$120,252, as of March 8, 1993.

A non-refundable fee of \$15.00 will be charged for each set of plans and specifications to cover reproduction costs.





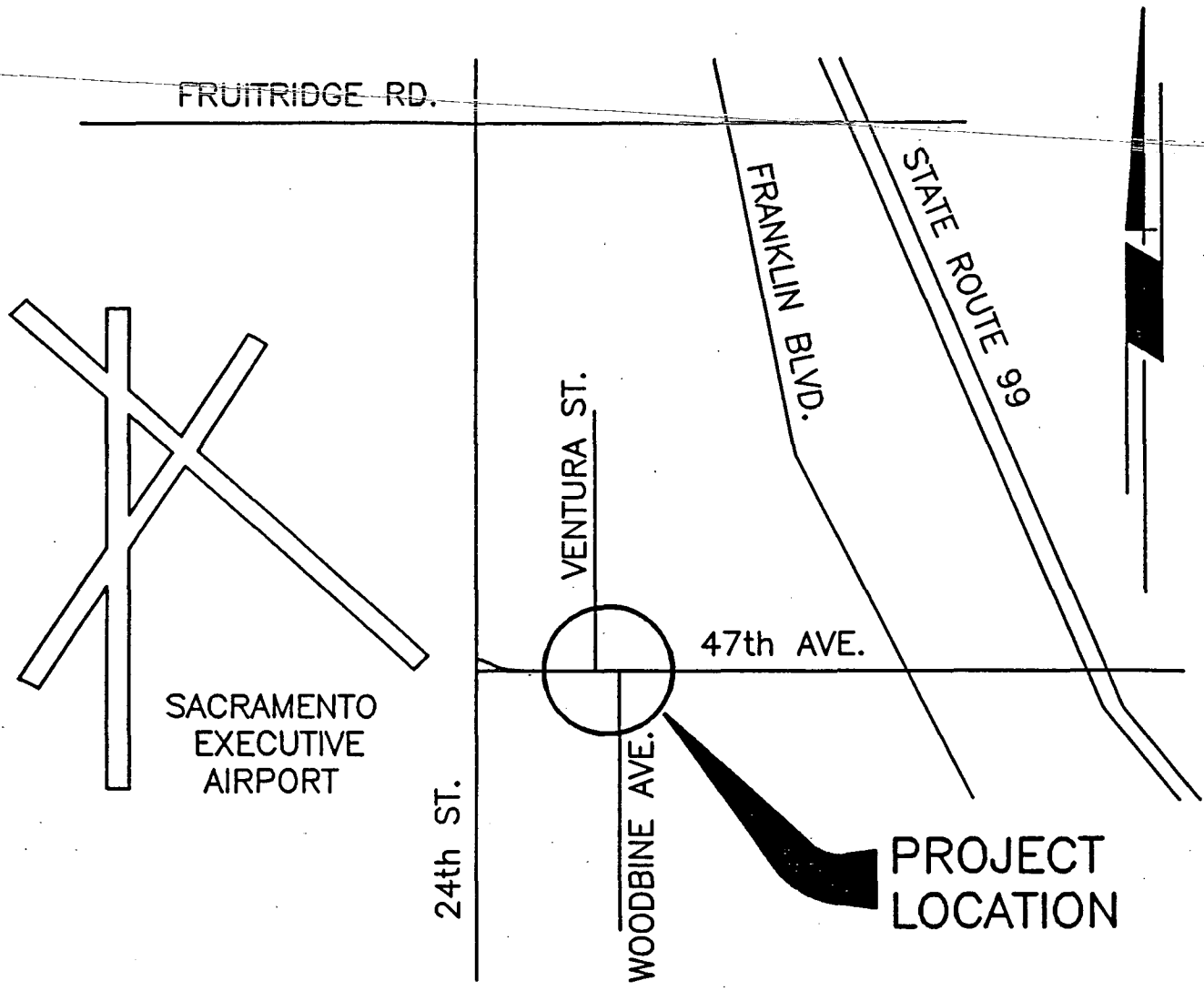
