

Resolution of Intention No. 2698

Pursuant to a law of the State of California, known as Division 7 of the Streets and Highways Code, the Improvement Act of 1911."

It is hereby resolved that it is the intention of the City Council of the City of Sacramento to order the following street work to be done, to-wit:

The improvement of the following in the City of Sacramento:

The Alley first South of H Street from the easterly line of 48th Street to the westerly line of 50th Street; Right-of-Way owned by the City of Sacramento along the easterly line of Lot 45 of Wright & Kimbrough Tract No. 34 (as the same is shown on the official Plat thereof filed in the office of the Sacramento County Recorder) by removing and disposing of all refuse and surplus materials; installing cast-iron gutter drain and connecting same to sewer system with 6 inch vitrified ironstone sewer pipe; installing a concrete retaining wall; constructing manholes complete with cast iron curbs and covers; removing and replacing concrete curb, gutter, sidewalk and asphaltic concrete as shown on Plan; grading and constructing a hydraulic concrete pavement.

All of said work to be done in accordance with the "Standard Specifications for the Improvement of Streets and Alleys and for the Construction of Sewers", heretofore adopted by the City Council and also in accordance with detailed Plans made therefore by the City Engineer and on file in his office having been approved by the City Council on May 7, 1948.

Cast-iron gutter drain shall be as shown on Cut #11 of said Specifications.

Manhole covers shall be as shown on cut No. 1B of said Specifications.

Concrete curb & gutter shall be as shown on Cut #6 of said Specifications.

Hydraulic concrete pavement shall be Class "D" concrete as specified in Section 26 of said Specifications and made with High Early-Strength Portland Cement as shown in Section 25, 26, and 27 of said Specifications.

Asphaltic concrete pavement shall be constructed as provided in Section 29 of said Specifications, and
