SUBJECT: Resolution Authorizing the Installation of Undulations

in the Alley Adjacent to the Sacramento Children's Home

and Approval of the Cooperative Agreement

SUMMARY

It is recommended that the attached resolution and cooperative agreement authorizing the Sacramento Children's Home to privately fund and construct undulations in the alley adjacent to their property be forwarded to the City Council for approval.

BACKGROUND

In July of 1987, a group of citizens residing on the east side of East Pacific Avenue between Sutterville Road and Wilmington Avenue requested that the City provide traffic controls in the alley behind their homes and adjacent to the Sacramento Children's Home. A cooperative effort between the citizen's group, Councilmember Joe Serna, the Fire Department, the Transportation Division, and the Administrator of the Children's Home resulted in a compromise solution, supported by all parties. The solution would allow the Children's Home to hire a private contractor to construct two sets of undulations in the subject alley. Administrators of the Children's Home have allocated necessary funding for the installation of undulations but must first obtain the required City Council approval to allow the installation of undulations in the alley. The responsibilities of the City and the Children's Home are set forth in the attached cooperative agreement.

The subject alley runs north/south between Sutterville Road and Wilmington Avenue, and is located between Franklin Boulevard and East Pacific Avenue (please see attached map). It is 20' in width, 930' in length and constructed of concrete. Because it is an alley and less than 1500 feet in length, it is not consistent with current undulation policy. Traffic studies conducted in the alley have shown volumes in excess of 800 vehicles daily with an average speed of 22 M.P.H., well over the prima facia alley speed of 15 M.P.H. The excessive volumes and speeds are a result of 'short-cut' traffic as the alley more conveniently aligns with Arlington Avenue to the south than does East Pacific Avenue.

The impacts on residents of East Pacific Avenue, whose garages have access from the alley, are increased noise and the inability to safely exit their garages. Representatives of the Children's Home have expressed concerns regarding the speed and volume of traffic in the alley as this relates to the safety of the children living at the Home. In addition, the busses travelling to and from the Home use the alley for access and must contend with the "short-cut" traffic. Little league fields which front the alley are also impacted by the noise, speed and volume of traffic.

FINANCIAL

No City funds are requested. All construction costs will be borne by the Children's Home. The City will be responsible for the signing and striping of the undulations, and sufficient funding for this is in the Transportation Division's Operating Budget.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the Joint Transportation and Community Development/ Budget and Finance Committees forward to the full City Council for approval the attached resolution which:

- 1) Authorizes the installation of undulations on the alley bounded by Sutterville Road, Wilmington Avenue, East Pacific Avenue and the Children's Home, and
- 2) Authorizes the City Manager and City Clerk to execute the attached Cooperative Agreement outlining the responsibilities of the City and the Sacramento Children's Home,


