Inspection report:

On October 15, 2002, a representative of our firm visited the Harley Davidson Motorcycle dealership at 1000 Arden Way, Sacramento, CA, 95815. An inspection was performed on a dynamometer installation.

The system consists, generally of the following items of equipment:

- Motorcycle holding platform with roller drum that is turned by the motorcycle rear tire
- Eddy current brake that restrains the roller and applies load to the motorcycle
- Eddy current brake controller
- Load sensing instruments
- Computer, monitor, and performance data recorder

The dynamometer was manufactured by Dynojet Company of Belgrade, Montana.

The system installation includes fans to remove gases and/or vapors from the operation of the motorcycle.

The system operates on 120 volts, AC.

Each item of equipment was inspected and a check sheet was prepared for the system. Each item was checked for proper electrical grounding of exposed metallic parts.


All systems substantially met the applicable codes, and acceptance inspection stickers were applied to the equipment.

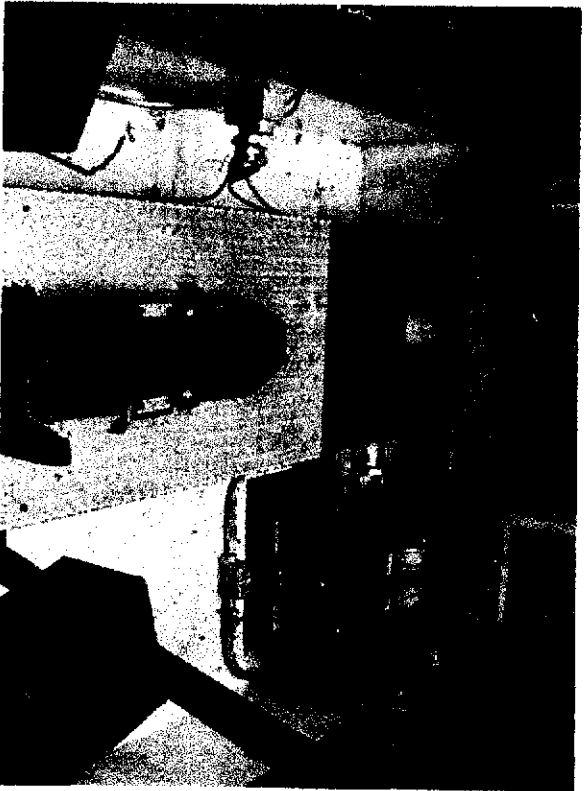
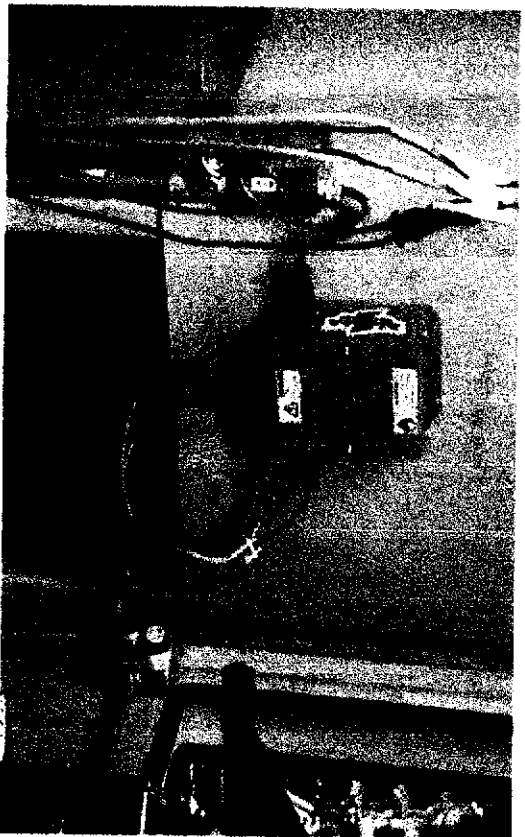
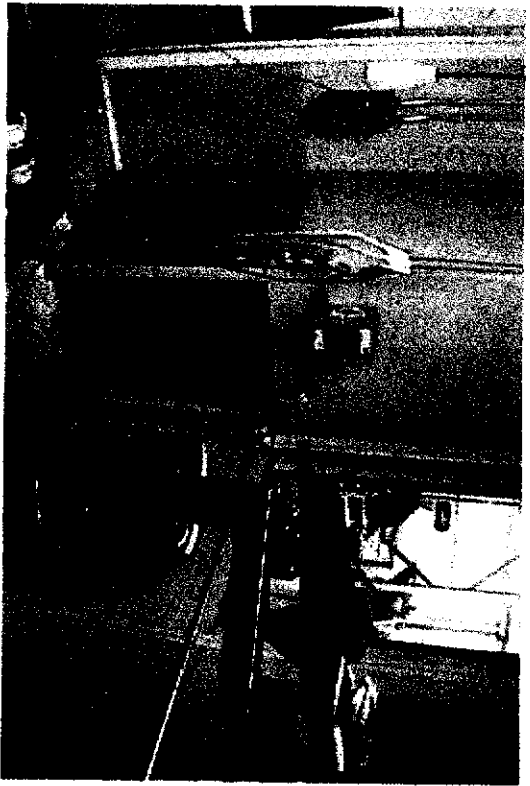
