Description/Analysis

Issue: Rendering of City Treasurer monthly investment transactions report to the City Council.

Policy Considerations: The City Treasurer routinely reports on monthly investment transactions to keep the City Council advised of current investment activity.

Environmental Considerations:

California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA): Under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) guidelines, continuing administrative activities do not constitute a project and are therefore exempt from review.

Sustainability Considerations: There are no sustainability considerations applicable to this action.

Commission/Committee Action: None

Rationale for Recommendation: The City Treasurer is responsible for investing and reporting in accordance with the authority granted by City Charter Section 73, City Council ordinances and resolutions, and applicable state law.

Financial Considerations: The monthly investment report sets forth the monthly transactions of the City Treasurer's Office Investment Pool A funds. Portfolio value on February 1, 2010 was \$640,140,052 and at month end the value was \$614,969,588. The interest yield for the month was 2.35%. There were 8 total transactions for the period (3 buys and 5 maturities). The estimated duration of the portfolio is 1.53 years.

Consistent with the Investment Policy adopted by City Council on August 18, 2009, the monthly report herein includes the content described in Government Code sections 53607 and 63646 (b).

Emerging Small Business Development (ESBD): Because this transaction does not involve the purchase of goods or services for the City, ESBD efforts are not applicable.

Background Information:

California Statutes Chapter 783, Statutes of 1995 and Chapter 749, Statutes of 1996 were enacted to help avoid a repeat of the December 1994 Orange County investment fiasco which resulted in investment losses exceeding \$1.7 billion for Orange County and other local government entities. These statutes made revisions to certain state laws that addressed the investing of public funds, including, among other things, the requirement of reporting investment activity on a periodic basis. Government Code section 53607 requires monthly reports to the City Council. Commencing March, 1997, the City Treasurer, as the person vested with authority to invest City funds, has rendered monthly transaction reports to the City Council and this staff report accompanies the latest of such reports. This practice is consistent with prior City Council principles regarding investment authority that emphasizes full disclosure and prompt reporting of investment policy, strategies, programs and actual investments as reflected in Resolution 95-108.

For informational purposes, the City Treasurer also reports on transactions of other funds invested by the Treasurer's Office in addition to the City's funds. On February 23, 2010, the Investment Team purchased two \$5 million dollar bonds (one each for Pool A and SHRA's Pool D) issued by the Federal National Mortgage Association (Fannie Mae). The bonds mature on September 8, 2015, giving them a term in excess of the maximum 5-year term required by the City's Investment Policy, by just over six months. However, the bonds are subject to be called in approximately one year. They bear coupon interest at the rate of 1% and were purchased at a discount to provide a yield of 30 basis points over comparable 1-year bonds. If the bonds are not called, the bonds will bear interest at the rate of 4.1%. The Investment Team believes the bonds will be called in one year as prevailing rates must grow by 260 basis points for Fannie Mae not to call the bonds, a circumstance that the Investment Team believes has little chance in occurring in the next 12 months. Accordingly, the investment reasonably can be considered a one-year investment. Given the lack of credit risk with Fannie Mae bonds and the above-market rates on the bonds before call and after if there is no call, the bonds make a solid investment.
