Fiscal Year (FY) 2020 California Commission on Peace Officer Standards and Training (POST), Innovations Grant Program (IGP)

BACKGROUND

- A. The Commission on Peace Officer Standards and Training (POST) has developed the Innovations Grant Program (IGP). The IGP is designed to grant funds on a competitive basis to qualified public and private entities for the purpose of fostering innovations in training and procedures for law enforcement officers, with the goal of reducing the number of officer-involved shootings statewide. The grant funding will enable the Sacramento Police Department (SPD) to create a Wellness Series under the grant topic area of Wellness Programs for Law Enforcement Officers designed to incorporate areas such as use of force and de-escalation. Awards are restricted to qualified public or private entities and include community-based non-profit organizations, law enforcement agencies, educational or law enforcement training institutions and private for-profit organizations. The Sacramento Police Department (SPD) proposes to use this allocation to institute and implement this multi-session program to better the lives, reduce stress, enhance confidence, lessen anxiety and boost mental and physical health of its officers.
- B. There is a need to introduce an innovative training program geared toward wellness programs for law enforcement officers. Educating, reinforcing and instilling a mindset for overall wellness will increase an officer's performance and impact the officer's ability to make critical decisions during contacts with the public and in critical incidents. Grant funding will support SPD's efforts to develop innovative training for law enforcement officers with the goal of reducing the number of officer-involved shootings statewide.

BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. The City Manager, or the City Manager's designee, is authorized to accept a grant award of \$134,185 for the Fiscal Year 2020 California Peace Officer Standards and Training Innovations Grant Program Award;
- Section 2. The City Manager, or the City Manager's Designee, is authorized to establish an operating grant project (G11017700) to implement the grant; and

Section 3. The City Manager, or the City Manager's designee, is authorized to establish revenue and expenditure budgets in the amount of \$134,185 in G11017700.
