DIRECTING FILING OF ANNUAL REPORT FOR THE ADDITIONAL LIBRARY SERVICES ASSESSMENT DISTRICT NO. 96-02 AND SETTING DATE FOR PUBLIC HEARING (PURSUANT TO CITY CODE TITLE 3.136 (ARTICLE VI, SECTION 3.136.180)

BACKGROUND

- A. The Additional Library Services Assessment District No. 96-02 was established by the City Council and approved by the registered voters on November 5, 1996.
- B. The City Council established the District in accordance with the provisions of City Code 3.136.
- C. Pursuant to City Code 3.136.380, an annual report shall be prepared for each fiscal year that assessments are levied.
- D. Pursuant to City Code 3.136.380 a public hearing shall be held to consider the District budget and annual levy.
- E. The City Council is fully advised in this matter.

- Section 3: Pursuant to City Code 3.136.380, at the hour of 2:00 pm on Tuesday, July 18, 2006, the City Council will conduct a public hearing on the question of the levy of the proposed annual assessment. The hearing will be held at the meeting place of the City Council located in the City Hall, 915 I Street, First Floor, Sacramento, California.

Section 4: This resolution is adopted pursuant to of City Code 3.136, Article IV and Article VI.
