

ORDINANCE NO. 1092, FOURTH SERIES.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 23 OF ORDINANCE NO. 1029, FOURTH SERIES, PASSED NOVEMBER 27, 1944, AND ENTITLED: "AN ORDINANCE REGULATING FOOD HANDLING ESTABLISHMENTS IN THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO; DEFINING THE SAME; PROVIDING FOR THE ISSUANCE OF PERMITS FROM THE HEALTH OFFICER; PROVIDING FOR THE REVOCATION, SUSPENSION AND RENEWAL OF SAID PERMITS; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH; PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS THEREOF; AND MAKING THIS ORDINANCE AN EMERGENCY MEASURE TO TAKE EFFECT IMMEDIATELY."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

SECTION 1: Section 23 of Ordinance No. 1029, Fourth Series, passed November 27, 1944, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 23: No dogs, cats or other animals shall be harbored or permitted in a public eating place, except dogs trained to assist persons of impaired vision when such dogs are accompanied by a person who is forced to depend upon the assistance of such an animal by reason of impaired vision.
