

ORDINANCE NO. 1995, FOURTH SERIES.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SUBSECTION (a) OF SECTION 1201, ARTICLE 12, PART III, AND SUB-SECTION (a) OF SECTION 1303, ARTICLE 13, PART III, OF ORDINANCE NO. 936, FOURTH SERIES, PASSED OCTOBER 17, 1941, APPROVING AND ENACTING BY REFERENCE ALL OF THE PROVISIONS OF THE NATIONAL ELECTRICAL CODE NOVEMBER 1956 EDITION, IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE PROVISIONS OF SECTIONS 50022.1 TO 50022.8 OF THE GOVERNMENT CODE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

SECTION 1: Sub-section (a) of Section 1201, Article 12, Part III, of Ordinance No. 936, Fourth Series, passed October 17, 1941, is hereby amended to read as follows:

(a) Except as provided otherwise herein, all installations whereby electrical energy is to be dissipated or utilized shall be in strict conformity with the provisions of statutes of the State of California; the rules and regulations of the Department of Industrial Relations, Division of Industrial Safety, as embodied in their Electrical Safety Orders, under authority of the State Statutes governing industrial and commercial installations; with the Rules and Regulations of the Commission of Immigration and Housing of the State of California; and with the most approved methods of construction for safety of life and property. The Regulations as laid down in the National Electrical Code, 1956 Edition, published by the National Fire Protection Association (International) 60 Batterymarch Street, Boston 10, Massachusetts, may be prima facie evidence of such most approved methods. Three copies of said National Electrical Code, Edition of November, 1956, are on file in the office of the City Clerk, to which reference is hereby made.

SECTION 2: Sub-section (a) of Section 1303, Article 13, Part III, of Ordinance No. 936, Fourth Series, passed October 17, 1941, is hereby amended to read as follows:



WATTAGE REQUIREMENTS


(a) Wattage requirements in residential, commercial, industrial and other occupancies shall be as specified in the National Electrical Code, Edition of November, 1956, published by the National Fire Protection Association (International) 60 Batterymarch Street, Boston 10, Massachusetts, and in accordance with the applicable orders of the Department of Industrial Relations, Division of Industrial Safety, as embodied in their Electrical Safety Orders, Edition of February, 1955. A copy of said Electrical Safety Orders is on file in the office of the City Clerk, to which reference is hereby made. (That said National Electrical Code, Edition of November, 1956, as published by the National Fire Protection Association (International) was heretofore approved by the Attorney General of the State of California as a proper code for enactment by reference pursuant to the provisions of Section 50022.1 of the Government Code, and that prior to the enactment of this ordinance, the City Council duly and regularly held a public hearing after publication of notice at least 15 days, and another at least 8 days prior to the date of hearing; all in accordance with said Section 50022.3 of the Government Code.)

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall be published once in the official newspaper of said City of Sacramento and shall take effect 30 days from and after its passage.
