

RESOLUTION NO. 2007-003

Adopted by the Sacramento City Council

January 4, 2007

AWARD A CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT AND TRANSFER FUNDS FOR THE SUMP 42 IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT (PN: XI36)

BACKGROUND

- A. The Sump 42 Improvements project will rebuild the existing sewer lift station by converting this station to a submersible pump station which will improve reliability and reduce maintenance costs.
- B. The Sump 42 Improvements project was advertised for bidding and bids were received on December 6, 2006. JR Sharp Construction was lowest responsible bidder.

BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. The contract plans and specifications for the Sump 42 Improvements Project are approved, and the contract is awarded to JR Sharp Construction for an amount not to exceed \$174,350.
- Section 2. Transfer funds in the amount of \$120,000 from the Sewer Fund Base Reserve (PN: XE01, fund 414) to the Sump 42 Improvements project (PN: XI36, fund 414).


