

ORDINANCE NO. 1081, FOURTH SERIES.

AN ORDINANCE WHICH IS A DIRECTION BY THE CITY COUNCIL THAT CERTAIN SEWER REPAIR WORK SHALL BE DONE BY THE CITY WITHOUT FIRST ADVERTISING FOR BIDS IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE RECOMMENDATION OF THE CITY MANAGER PURSUANT TO THE PROVISIONS OF SECTION 251 OF THE CITY CHARTER, AND MAKING THIS AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE TO TAKE EFFECT IMMEDIATELY.

WHEREAS, there is an immediate urgent need that the 84-inch main sewer east of Sump No. 1 in the City of Sacramento be repaired immediately; and

WHEREAS, the urgency of the work and the uncertainty of the amount of work to be done makes the advertising for bids impractical;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

SECTION 1: The City Manager of the City of Sacramento is hereby directed and authorized to cause the necessary sewer repair work needed to repair the 84-inch main sewer east of Sump No. 1 in the City of Sacramento to be done by the City without first advertising for bids, pursuant to the provisions of Section 251 of the Charter of the City of Sacramento.

SECTION 2: This ordinance is hereby made an emergency measure to take effect immediately; such emergency being that it is necessary that the work referred to herein be completed with as little delay as possible for the protection of the health of the people of the City of Sacramento.
