During the upcoming forum, City staff will present on various scenarios for city of Sacramento's 30 year plan for further growth. The issues will be the topic of the Leadership Forum that Commissioners will be participating in on February 20, 2007 along with City Council, City Leadership and other City appointed Board and Commission members.

The Plan is an opportunity to take a step back and envision the future. The elected and appointed City leaders are the General Plan implementation team and the work with the City will both create impacts and be impacted by the choices made together during the workshop. Please use your unique experience to help make decisions that are in the best interests of the City and all of our current and future residents.

The workshop will involve a review of our overall vision for the City, a discussion the guiding principles and small group discussion to view the potential futures for key areas of the City that are likely to transform during the planning timeframe of the general plan.

This is an opportunity for the Disability Community's expertise to contribute their expertise.

The bulk of the workshop will focus on land use, reflecting the next key decision facing the City Council - selection of a preferred land use scenario that can accommodate a substantial projected increase in population and employment over the next 25 years. Our city's shared challenge is to grow in a way that sustains a high quality of life for our residents, a healthy economy, and a clean environment.

The Commissioners asked questions about some of the various projects that were included in the Workbook.
