**AUTHORIZATION FOR SACRAMENTO
HOUSING AND REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY TO APPLY FOR, ACCEPT, AND
ADMINISTER THE EXTERIOR ACCESSIBILITY GRANTS FOR RENTERS
PROGRAM IN THE NAME OF AND
ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO**

WHEREAS, the City of Sacramento, a political subdivision of the State of California, desires to apply for and receive an allocation of funds through the Exterior Accessibility Grants for Renters Program (EAGR); and

WHEREAS, the California Department of Housing and Community Development ("HCD") has issued a Notice of Funding Availability ("NOFA") for the EAGR established by Chapter 4, Section 53533(5) (B) of Part 11 of Division 31 of the Health and Safety Code (the "statute"). Pursuant to the statute, HCD is authorized to approve funding allocations utilizing monies made available by passage of Proposition 46, the Housing and Emergency Shelter Trust Fund Act of 2002 to the EAGR Program, subject to the terms and conditions of the statute and the EARG Program Guidelines adopted by HCD on October 1, 2003; and

WHEREAS, the City, by its agent, the Sacramento Housing and Redevelopment Agency, ("Agency") wishes to submit an application to obtain from HCD an allocation of Exterior Accessibility Grants for Renters Program in the amount of \$500,000.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

Section 1. The City delegates authority to the Agency to submit an application to HCD on behalf of and in the name of the City of Sacramento to participate in the Exterior Accessibility Grants for Renters Program in response to the NOFA, which will request a funding allocation in the amount not to exceed \$500,000.

Section 2. The City delegates authority to the Agency to receive funding from HCD in the name of the City and to administer the Exterior Accessibility Grants for Renters Program.

Section 3. The City authorizes the Agency to execute, on behalf of itself and the City, the Standard Agreement and all instruments necessary or required by HCD for participation in the Exterior Accessibility Grants for Renters Program, as currently established in the applicable law and regulations.


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
Section 4. The City, for itself and the Agency, adopts the Exterior Accessibility Grants for Renters Program Guidelines established by HCD on October 1, 2003 and as described in Attachment I.

Section 5. The Agency will develop and adopt Local EAGR Program Guidelines for administration of the program.

Section 6. The Agency will amend the Agency Budget to receive and expend not more than \$500,000 under the Exterior Accessibility Grants for Program revenue.
