

RESOLUTION NO. 2007-687

AWARD CONTRACT FOR J STREET SEWER REPLACEMENT 18TH TO 20TH STREET (PN: XN51)

BACKGROUND

- A. The combined sewer system pipeline in J Street, 18th to 20th Streets is in poor condition and has deteriorated beyond repair. Cracks and bad joints are abundant in these pipes. Consistent with the criteria set forth in the Department of Utilities' Infrastructure Replacement and Management Program, these sections of pipe have failed and replacement is necessary. Additionally, substandard maintenance holes and drain inlets will also be replaced.
- B. City staff prepared the plans and contract specifications to replace approximately 600 linear feet of combined sewer pipeline, including manholes and drain inlets to improve these facilities and ensure public safety. The project was advertised for bidding and 4 bids were received on August 15, 2007. AC General Engineering, Inc. was the lowest responsible bidder.

BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. The contract plans and specifications for the J Street Sewer Replacement 18th to 20th Street Project (PN:XN51) is approved, and the contract is awarded to AC General Engineering, Inc. for an amount not to exceed \$156,598.
