SUBJECT: TRAFFIC UNDULATIONS 1993/94 (PN:SH86) - CONTRACT AWARD

LOCATION AND COUNCIL DISTRICT: City-wide (See Attached)

RECOMMENDATION:

This report recommends that the City Council:

- Accept the low bid of \$64,605.00 from R.C. Collet, Inc.
- Award the contract for the Traffic Undulations 1993/94 to R.C. Collet, Inc.

SUMMARY:

This project will construct asphaltic concrete undulations over existing pavement at various locations in the City of Sacramento (See Attachment). The project will result in lower motor vehicle speeds and provide increased public safety and enhancement of existing neighborhoods. Because there are no subcontracting opportunities on this project, the City Manager approved a waiver of MBE/WBE participation goals for this project.



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Bids were received and opened on April 6, 1994 and contract award is recommended.

COMMITTEE/COMMISSION ACTION: None.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

This project will construct asphaltic concrete undulations over existing pavement at various locations in the City of Sacramento. The project will result in lower motor vehicle speeds and provide increased public safety and enhancement of existing neighborhoods. This project is a continuation of the program to install undulations on residential City streets where there has been a history of excessive vehicle speed.

On March 8, 1994, the City Council approved the plans and specifications for the Traffic Undulations 1993/94 project. Bids were received and opened by the City Clerk on April 6, 1994. The bids received were:

R.C. Collet, Inc.	\$64,605.00
Biondi Paving, Inc.	\$71,394.00
Granite Construction Co.	\$71,832.00

NOTE: There were no MBE or WBE bidders.

The estimated project completion date is July 29, 1994.

FINANCIAL CONSIDERATIONS:

The engineer's estimated construction cost was \$68,000.00.

The current estimated total project cost, including all planning, design and construction costs, is \$159,997.00. The current budget is \$160,000.00, which was approved in the 1993/94 Capital Improvement Program from the Gas Tax Fund (202). The funds available for this project amount to \$127,809.00, as of April 21, 1994.

POLICY CONSIDERATIONS:

The subject project promotes City Council priorities regarding neighborhood revitalization and enhancement and public safety.

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This action is consistent with Title 58, Chapter 58.03.304 of the City Code concerning award of contract and Resolution No. 93-619 relating to MBE/WBE participation goals and policies adopted by the City Council on November 2, 1993.

MBE/WBE:

There are no subcontracting opportunities on this project. Pursuant to the City of Sacramento's Minority/Women-Owned Business Enterprise Program, Administrative Procedures, Section 3.2, Modification of Goals, staff requested and received from the City Manager a waiver of MBE/WBE participation goals for this project.

As provided for under Resolution 93-169 relative to MBE/WBE participation goals and policies adopted by the City Council on November 2, 1993, City certified MBE/WBE bidders and non-MBE/WBE bidders achieving the City of Sacramento's MBE/WBE participation goals for construction projects may be eligible for bid price preferences up to 7%, or a maximum of \$25,000.00, whichever is lower.

There were five (5) planholders for this project; none of which were MBE/WBEs. Three bids were received for the project. No MBE/WBEs submitted bids. No subcontractors were listed with any of the bids received. The price preferences available to bidders achieving MBE/WBE participation goals under Resolution No. 93-619 adopted by the City Council on November 2, 1993, did not affect the rank order of the bids received.

Plans and specifications were sent to seven (7) plan rooms and construction services organizations for publication and use by the construction industry of Northern California. There are four (4) organizations on the distribution list that are directly involved with outreach to MBE/WBE contractors.


Other MBE/WBE outreach efforts for this project included:

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
