SUMMARY

This report provides information relating to the implementation of the County art programs for the Warren Youth Center/Boys Ranch and the Work Release Facility and recommends the following: 1) authorize the City Manager to execute the agreements relating to the art projects; and 2) an increase in appropriations of \$2,454 to the FY 83-84 budget of the Metropolitan Arts Division for administration of the art projects.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

On January 17, 1984 the Board of Supervisors approved a proposal for the Sacramento Metropolitan Arts Commission to develop art proposals for three facilities: The Warren Youth Center/Boys Ranch and the Work Release Facility. The Board approved art budgets of \$22,500 for the Work Release Facility and a combined amount of \$3,554 for the Warren Youth Center/Boys Ranch. In addition, the Board approved funds be allocated to the Metropolitan Arts Division to cover administrative costs of the development of the proposal.

Implementation of the art program requires an agreement between the City and County of Sacramento. Major provisions of the agreement include:

1. The Metropolitan Arts Commission agrees to provide the County with recommendations for the most appropriate artwork within \$22,500 for the Work Release Facility and \$3,554 for the Warren Youth Center/Boys Ranch.
2. The County agrees to pay City for administration of the art projects not to exceed \$4,500 for the Work Release Facility and \$454 for the Warren Youth Center/Boys Ranch.

FINANCIAL DATA

Administration of the projects shall not exceed \$4,954. Administration costs, including staff time of \$2,500 and other expenditures of \$2,454 will be reimbursed by the County of Sacramento. No additional City funds are necessary.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the City Council authorize, by resolution,

1. The City Manager, on behalf of the City of Sacramento, to execute the contract between the City and County of Sacramento, for the purpose of developing an art program for the Work Release Facility and the Warren Youth Center/Boys Ranch.
2. An increase in appropriations to the Art in Public Places Program of the Metropolitan Arts Division of \$2,454 for the purpose of implementing the art program for the Work Release Facility and the Warren Youth Center/Boys Ranch.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:
