AMEND 1990/91 CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECT BY ESTABLISHING NEW CIP FOR SOUTH LAND PARK HILLS UNIT #24 STREET LIGHTING ASSESSMENT DISTRICT NO. 90-01 (JN:2115/25AD), IMPROVEMENT PROCEEDINGS NO. 90-01 -- AMENDING THE 1990/91 REVENUE BUDGET AND APPROPRIATE THE FUNDS

SUMMARY

It is requested that the Budget and Finance Committee recommend approval of the attached resolution to establish a new CIP Project, amend the Revenue Budget, and appropriate funds for the 1990/91 budget. This funding will allow the Department of Public Works to install street light improvements in the South Land Park Hills Unit #24 Street Lighting Assessment District No. 90-01.

BACKGROUND

On July 17, 1990, the City Council adopted several resolutions initiating the proceedings for this assessment district. A public hearing was held on September 4, 1990. At this hearing, the City Council approved formation of the district and commenced the 30-day cash collection period.

Bids were received on August 14, 1990. A low bid of \$39,992 was submitted by M&M Electric. On October 23, 1990, we will return to City Council to obtain authorization for the sale of bonds and award of contract to M&M Electric (please reference attached schedule). The district will provide street lighting in the area generally bounded by El Encanto Way on the north, South Land Park Drive on the south, Interstate 5 on the west, and 13th Street on the east.

FINANCIAL DATA

The funds necessary for this project are to be supported by assessments that may be collected during the 30-day cash collection period and revenue that is forthcoming from the sale of bonds on the unpaid assessments. The attached resolution will establish a CIP project known as the South Land Park Hills Unit #24 Street Lighting Assessment District No. 90-01, amend the 1990/91 Revenue Budget, and appropriate the funds. A summary of the project costs, based on our engineer's estimate, are as follows:

RECOMMENDATION

It is requested that the Budget and Finance Committee recommend approval of the appropriation of funds for the South Land Park Hills Unit #24 Street Lighting Assessment District No. 90-01 and forward this report to the full City Council for adoption of the attached resolution, which establishes a new project, amends the 1990/91 Revenue Budget and appropriates and transfer funds.

STREET LIGHTING ASSESSMENT DISTRICT NO. 90-01 (25AD)
AMENDING THE 1990/91 REVENUE BUDGET AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS

IMPROVEMENT PROCEEDING NO. 90-01

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO THAT:

- 1. The City Capital Improvement Program is hereby amended by establishing the project known as South Land Park Hills Unit #24 Street Lighting Assessment District No. 90-01.
- 2. The following appropriation increase is to be supported by revenue that is forthcoming from the payments received by property owners during the 30-day collection period and from the sale of bonds to be issued on all unpaid assessments. The 1990/91 Revenue Budget is hereby amended by increasing 662 ASD-25AD-3712, South Land Park Hills Unit #24 Street Lighting Assessment District No. 90-01 by \$56,876.53 (\$59,246.39, the amount charged to the property owners, minus \$2,369.86 for the bond discount).
- 3. The City Capital Improvement Program Budget is hereby amended by appropriating \$56,876.53 to the newly established project as follows:
