

ORDINANCE NO. 2034 FOURTH SERIES.

AN ORDINANCE VACATING AND ABANDONING STREET AND STRIPS RESERVED FOR SIDEWALKS AS SHOWN ON AMENDED PLAT NO. 1 OF COLONIAL HEIGHTS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

SECTION 1: All that portion of Lafayette Avenue, lying between the Westerly and Easterly production of the Northerly line of Lots 67 and 68 as shown on Amended Plat No. 1 of Colonial Heights, according to the official Plat thereof, filed in the office of the Recorder of Sacramento County on October 21, 1914, in Book 15 of Maps, Map No. 11, and the Southerly boundary of said Amended Plat No. 1 of Colonial Heights;

Three strips of land 14 feet in width lying East of and adjoining the East line of Lots 68, 84, 103 and 115; Three strips of land 14 feet in width lying West of ~~67~~ and adjoining the West line of Lots 67, 85, 102 and 117, all as shown on said Amended Plat No. 1 of Colonial Heights, are hereby declared vacated and abandoned.

Said vacating and abandoning is declared after due proceedings had therefor, according to law and a finding by the City Council, which is hereby made, that said Street and Strips herein described are unnecessary for present or prospective public street purposes.

SECTION 2: That the Clerk shall publish this ordinance once within 10 days after passage in the official newspaper of said City of Sacramento.
