

ORDINANCE NO. 1262, FOURTH SERIES.

AN ORDINANCE CLOSING, VACATING AND ABANDONING THAT PORTION OF THE ALLEY IN THE BLOCK BOUNDED BY NORTH B AND A STREETS, 18TH AND 19TH STREETS, LYING BETWEEN LINES DRAWN PARALLEL TO AND DISTANT 115 FEET AND 185 FEET RESPECTIVELY EASTERLY FROM THE CENTER LINE OF 18TH STREET, IN THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF

SACRAMENTO:

SECTION 1: That that portion of the alley in the Block bounded by North B and A Streets, 18th and 19th Streets, lying between lines drawn parallel to and distant 115 feet and 185 feet respectively easterly from the center line of 18th Street, in the City of Sacramento, State of California, is hereby declared closed, vacated and abandoned.

RESERVING, however, the right of entry to repair, maintain and construct sewer, water, and gas pipes and aerial or underground power, telephone and other communication facilities, now in place in said portion of said alley or which from time to time may be placed therein.

Said closing and vacating is declared after due proceedings had therefor, according to law and a finding by the City Council, which is hereby made, that said portion of said alley herein described is unnecessary for present or prospective public street purposes.
