

ORDINANCE NO. 1582, FOURTH SERIES.

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO HAVE INSTALLED AN UNDERGROUND DUCT LINE ON 21ST STREET, BETWEEN "H" AND "R" STREETS FOR FUTURE TRAFFIC SIGNAL INTERCONNECTION, WITHOUT FIRST ADVERTISING FOR BIDS, PURSUANT TO THE PROVISIONS OF SECTION 251 OF THE CITY CHARTER, AND MAKING THIS ORDINANCE AN EMERGENCY MEASURE TO TAKE EFFECT IMMEDIATELY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

SECTION 1: That the City Manager is hereby authorized to have installed an underground duct line on 21st Street, between "H" and "R" Streets, for future traffic signal interconnection, without first advertising for bids, pursuant to the provisions of Section 251 of the City Charter. The cost of said installation not to exceed \$3000.00 and to be expended out of the Major City Streets Gas Tax Funds, 1950-1951 Fiscal Year.

SECTION 2: That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and shall take effect immediately; such emergency being the necessity of placing this underground duct line in the street at a time when the Sacramento Municipal Utility District is also doing work to be placed in the same excavation.
