

RESOLUTION No. 209

Adopted by The Sacramento City Council on date of
August 15th, 1929

WHEREAS, the City of Sacramento has for many years been in extreme need of and has persistently endeavored to secure a new Federal Building in this City to adequately provide for the necessary Post Office facilities and accommodations for other branches of United States Government; and

WHEREAS, said Government has appropriated sum of \$1,300,000.00 for such purpose and out of said amount limited an apportionment of \$250,000.00 for the site, designating a portion of block H-1, 8th and 9th Streets; and

WHEREAS, foregoing maximum for said site is \$47,500.00 less than the purchase price thereof; and

WHEREAS, it is to the City's interest to have such structure located in block named and is also otherwise ideally situated for purpose intended; and

WHEREAS, interested citizens have offered and agreed to raise \$22,500.00 of the additional sum required for the acquisition of foregoing property, provided the Municipality will contribute the sum of \$25,000.00;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Sacramento expressing the sense of this body in favor of obligating the City in sum of \$25,000.00 to be applied on said purchase price deficiency, payable in annual installments with interest; first payment to be included in 1930 Budget and payable January 1st, 1930; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that matter be referred to City Manager and City Attorney to perfect all details in connection with the City's share of such purchase and presentation to City Council of further legal proceedings for the complete accomplishment of this Resolution.
