

Resolution of Award No. 2682

Resolved, that the City Council of the City of Sacramento, having in open session on the 9th day of April 19~~48~~, opened, examined, and publicly declared all sealed proposals or bids offered for the doing of the street work hereinafter mentioned,

Hereby rejects all of said bids, except that next hereinafter mentioned, and hereby awards the contract for said work to the lowest regular, responsible bidder, to-wit:

To LUPPEN and HAWLEY, INC.,
at the prices specified in their proposal for said work now on file.

The work herein referred to is the improvement of 55th Street from the center line of F Street to the center line of J Street; H Street from the westerly line of 54th Street to a point 50 feet easterly of the easterly line of 55th Street

in the City of Sacramento to the extent, with the materials and in the manner set forth in Resolution of Intention No. 2682, passed and adopted by said City Council on February 27th 1948, reference to which Resolution of Intention is hereby made for a description of said work and improvement.

The City Clerk is hereby directed to publish notice of this award twice in the Sacramento Union a daily newspaper published and circulated in said City of Sacramento, as required by law.
