

ORDINANCE NO. 939, FOURTH SERIES


AN ORDINANCE MAKING IT UNLAWFUL TO GIVE FALSE OR MISLEADING REPORT OF A MOTOR VEHICLE ACCIDENT, AND PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR VIOLATION OF THIS ORDINANCE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:


SECTION 1. No person shall knowingly or designedly make, give, or issue a false or misleading report of a motor vehicle accident involving either damage to property or injuries to persons, or shall make a false or misleading report of a stolen automobile, or of an automobile purported to be stolen, to the Police Department, Sheriff's office, or Highway Patrol Office.

SECTION 2. Any person violating this ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, punishable by a fine not to exceed \$100.00 or imprisonment in the city jail not to exceed 90 days.
