ORDINANCE NO. 1583, FOURTH SERIES.

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO CONTRACT WORK OF CLEANING OUT DEAD WOOD FROM TREES IN THE CITY CEMETERY AND McCLATCHY PARK, WITHOUT FIRST ADVERTISING FOR BIDS, PURSUANT TO SECTION 251 OF THE CITY CHARTER; AND MAKING THIS ORDINANCE AN EMERGENCY MEASURE TO TAKE EFFECT IMMEDIATELY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

SECTION 1. The City Manager is hereby authorized to contract work of cleaning out dead wood from trees in the City Cemetery and McClatchy Park, without first advertising for bids, pursuant to Section 251 of the City Charter. That there is hereby transferred from Line 1 to Line 2 (STREET TREE BUDGET 56) the sum of \$1500.00 to cover cost of said work.

SECTION 2. This ordinance is hereby declared an emergency measure and shall take effect immediately; such emergency being the immediate necessity of cleaning out said dead wood from trees in the City Cemetery and McClatchy Park to prevent injuries which might occur due to falling of dead wood from said trees.
