SUBJECT: Grant Application to Sacramento County for

SUMMARY

A resolution is required to authorize the submittal of an application for a grant of \$15,000 from Sacramento County for the Crocker Art Museum Division.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

On August 15, the Sacramento Board of Supervisors approved an allocation of \$150,000 to support the activities of cultural and civic groups in the Community. Funds will be distributed in accordance with criteria and a timetable established by the Board, based on the recommendations of the Sacramento Metropolitan Arts Commission.

The funds requested will support related operating expenses of the Museum "Art Ark" mobile outreach program throughout the City and County. This program serves adults and students on school sites and community facilities.
