1. The first section of the act provides for the establishment of a public health service, to be known as the Public Health Service of the United States. It is to be a part of the Department of Health and Human Services, and its functions are to be defined by the Secretary of Health and Human Services, subject to the approval of the President.

2. The second section of the act provides for the appointment of a Director of the Public Health Service, who shall be appointed by the President, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate, for a term of four years, and may be reappointed for one or more terms of four years each.

3. The third section of the act provides for the appointment of a Deputy Director of the Public Health Service, who shall be appointed by the President, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate, for a term of four years, and may be reappointed for one or more terms of four years each.

4. The fourth section of the act provides for the appointment of a Chief of the Bureau of Preventive Medicine, who shall be appointed by the President, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate, for a term of four years, and may be reappointed for one or more terms of four years each.

5. The fifth section of the act provides for the appointment of a Chief of the Bureau of Communicable Diseases, who shall be appointed by the President, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate, for a term of four years, and may be reappointed for one or more terms of four years each.
