
RESOLUTION AMENDING RESOLUTION NUMBER 118
ENTITLED: RESOLUTION CREATING THE OFFICE OF
EXECUTIVE SECRETARY TO THE CITY MANAGER OF
THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO, ADOPTED UNDER DATE
OF NOVEMBER 1, 1928.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO: THAT
RESOLUTION NO. 118 BE AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS:


That the office of Executive Secretary shall be that of Assistant to the City Manager, and he shall have such power and authority as shall be vested in him by said City Manager.

The said Executive Secretary shall receive the sum of THIRTY-SIX HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$3,600) per annum in full compensation for all services performed by him for the City of Sacramento, payable in equal monthly installments at the same time and in the same manner as other employees of the City are paid.
