Dear Mayor Isenberg:

The Sacramento Municipal Utility District is and has been concerned over the availability of future supplies of electrical energy to meet customer needs. One of the best and most economical ways of meeting future needs is to conserve our existing resources.

The District has embarked on many conservation programs of its own but needs the cooperation of all governmental entities to promote the most effective use of existing resources. The District, through this letter and previous actions, strongly urges the adoption of regulatory ordinances to require attic insulation in homes built prior to July 1, 1977 at a minimum R-value of 19 (R-19). Where cost effective and feasible, attic insulation can save considerable energy, thus benefiting the customer as well as the District.

The urging of your Council to adopt such regulatory measures includes the commitment by the District to publicize the need and benefits of insulation as a conservation measure, in addition to providing the attic inspections that such regulatory measures would require. Attached is a copy of SMUD Resolution No. 80-2-8 on this matter adopted by the Board of Directors on February 7, 1980.

The District appreciates your concern in this matter and looks forward to a cooperative program that will benefit all residents of the City of Sacramento.

RESOLUTION NO. 80-2-8

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS
OF SACRAMENTO MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT:

The General Manager is hereby directed, on behalf of the District, to write to the Board of Supervisors of the County of Sacramento and the City Council of the City of Sacramento urging those officials to adopt ordinances requiring that before homes built prior to July 1, 1977 are sold, attic insulation must meet a minimum R-value of 19 (R-19), where such R-value will be cost-effective, and further advising those officials that the District is willing to provide assistance by publicizing the need for such insulation, and by conducting such insulation inspection as may be required by these ordinances.
