SUBJECT: Application for SB-325 Funds

### SUMMARY

The Traffic Engineering Division has prepared the Fiscal Year 1981-82 Annual Transportation Claim for \$84,110 to be used to fund the Sacramento River Bikeway from Miller Park to Clipper Way.

### BACKGROUND INFORMATION

The Transportation Development Act of 1971 provided that two percent of a City's or County's SB-325 apportionment may be made available for facilities that provide for the exclusive use of bicyclists and pedestrians if such use is approved by the Transportation Planning Agency.

The Sacramento Area Council of Governments is the transportation planning agency for this area. To utilize these funds for Fiscal Year 1981-82, the attached claim for \$84,110 should be submitted to the Sacramento Area Council of Governments.

Funding is proposed for the Sacramento River Bikeway south of Miller Park. This project entails the construction of a Class I Bikeway on top of the levee from Miller Park to 25th Avenue and 35th Avenue to Clipper Way.

### FINANCIAL DATA

The claim \$84,110 will provide funding for the Sacramento River Bikeway south of Miller Park.



The City of Sacramento has been budgeting SB 325 funds since FY 1975-76 toward  
the Sacramento Northern Railroad Bikeway and the Sacramento River Bikeway. As  
of this date, the Sacramento Northern Railroad Bikeway projects completed are;  
the American River crossing, 14th Street Tunnel at SPRR, and signals and strip-  
ing on 14th Street. Construction of the Sacramento River Bikeway from Old Sacra-  
mento to Discovery Park is scheduled to begin this spring. The fiscal year 81-  
82 SB 325 funds will help finance the Sacramento River Bikeway from Miller Park  
to Clipper Way.
