

SPECIAL MEETING
SACRAMENTO CITY COUNCIL
June 8, 1965

The Honorable City Council met in Special Session on this date at the hour of 8:40 o'clock a. m., Mayor McKinney presiding and roll call was answered as follows:

Councilmen Marriott, McKinney, Mering, Murphy, Nielsen, Rouse, Talkin.

ABSENT: Councilmen Christensen and Domich.

Executed copies of the call of the meeting issued by the Mayor and presented by the City Clerk, were ordered filed.

The call stated the purpose of the meeting to be that of considering and acting upon matters relating to the City Budget for the 1965-66 fiscal year and to present such other matters as may regularly come before said body or be presented by the City Manager.

City Manager E. A. Fairbairn reviewed with the Members present that portion of the proposed 1965-66 Budget entitled Special Appropriations (Fixed Charges).

During said discussion, Council agreed with verbal recommendation of the City Manager that the group medical insurance appropriation be increase \$45,000.00, wiht \$20,000.00 of said increase to cover an anticipated increase in premium and \$25,000.00 of the increase to cover the City's participation in paying a portion of premiums for retired employees should the Council determine favorably at a future meeting.

During the City Manager's review of the Special Appropriation to the Transit Authority, Councilman Marriott again appealed for reconsideration of the matter of fare increase of the Transit Authority.

A communication from the Sacramento Downtown Association of Retailers, Property Owners, and Businessmen, dated May 27, 1965, urging the Council to consider a full subsidy of the Transit Authority was read and presented for the record by Mr. Albert O'Malley, Jr., Secretary Manager.

Following a general discussion, Councilman Mering moved that the City Subsidy of \$280,000.00 to the Transit Authority as listed in the tentative budgæ be approved. Seconded by Councilman Nielsen and carried by the following vote:

AYES: Councilmen McKinney, Mering, Murphy, Nielsen, Talkin.

ABSENT: Councilmen Christensen and Domich.

NOES: Councilmen Marriott and Rouse.

Councilman Marriott thereupon suggested that the Transit Authority review the total process of fixing Transit Authority bus fares.

Council agreed to the inclusion of \$7,380.00 to Budget No. 40 Street Lighting, to cover the anticipated salary of a General Repairman inadvertently left out of said budget.

The City Manager reviewed revenue estimates of 1965-66.

Councilman Marriott introduced the following resolution moving its adoption:
