SUBJECT: SUMP 35 PUMP STATION, (PN: WG56) TRANSFER FUNDS AND AWARD CONTRACT TO EAI INTERNATIONAL FOR AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$453,848.

LOCATION AND COUNCIL DISTRICT:

Sump 35 Pump Station Project is in Council district 4. See location map.

RECOMMENDATION:

Staff recommends that the City Council transfer funds, accept the bid from EAI International for an amount not to exceed \$453,848 and award the contract.

SUMMARY

On December 17, 1997, Sump 35 Pump Station Project was informally rebid. Bids were received from the three invited contractors and opened by the Project Manager on January 14, 1998. The low bidder was EAI International with a bid of \$453,848. It is proposed to award the contract to EAI International for \$453,848.

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COMMITTEE/COMMISSION ACTION

None.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

- The pump station is located at the end of Myrtle Vista Avenue near Pocket Road and Interstate 5; storm drain pipe starts from Sharon Way and extends to pump station 35.
- Approximately 450 feet of pipe will be removed and replaced with 1,120 feet of 30-36 inch drainage main. This includes placing 6 manholes, 270 feet of drain lead, 12 Ditch Boxes and 1 storm sump.

Bids were received from three (3) contractors, as follows:

Note: Contractors who met both MBE and WBE participation goals are indicated with a double asterisk (**).

The engineer's estimated construction cost was \$532,000. The estimated completion date is September 1998.

FINANCIAL CONSIDERATIONS

The total estimated cost for this project including costs incurred to date has been amended to \$648,508. The current budget for this project is \$300,000. Staff recommends that \$350,000 be transferred to this project from (425-500-WE71-4414) Base CIP Reserve, which has an unobligated balance of \$377,241 as of January 29, 1998.

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ENVIRONMENTAL CONSIDERATIONS

The Environmental Services Division has determined that this project is categorically exempt pursuant to State Class 1 and 2 and Section Number 15302(c) of the California Environmental Quality Act.

POLICY CONSIDERATION

This action is consistent with Chapter 58, Article III, Section 58.304 of the City Code concerning award of contracts.

MBE/WBE

EAI International has submitted good faith effort documentation which has been reviewed and deemed adequate. As part of it's good faith efforts, EAI used the City's Web Page to find contractors for notification. Because of the way the Web Page is formatted and some out of date information therein, some of the information EAI obtained was not acceptable. Since this was through no fault of EAI, staff has determined that EAI's effort is acceptable. EAI international has therefore been recommended for award. The cumulative departmental MBE/WBE participation to date is 19.32% MBE and 15.34% WBE.

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The MBE/WBE participation achieved by all bidders as identified in their bids is listed in the following table:





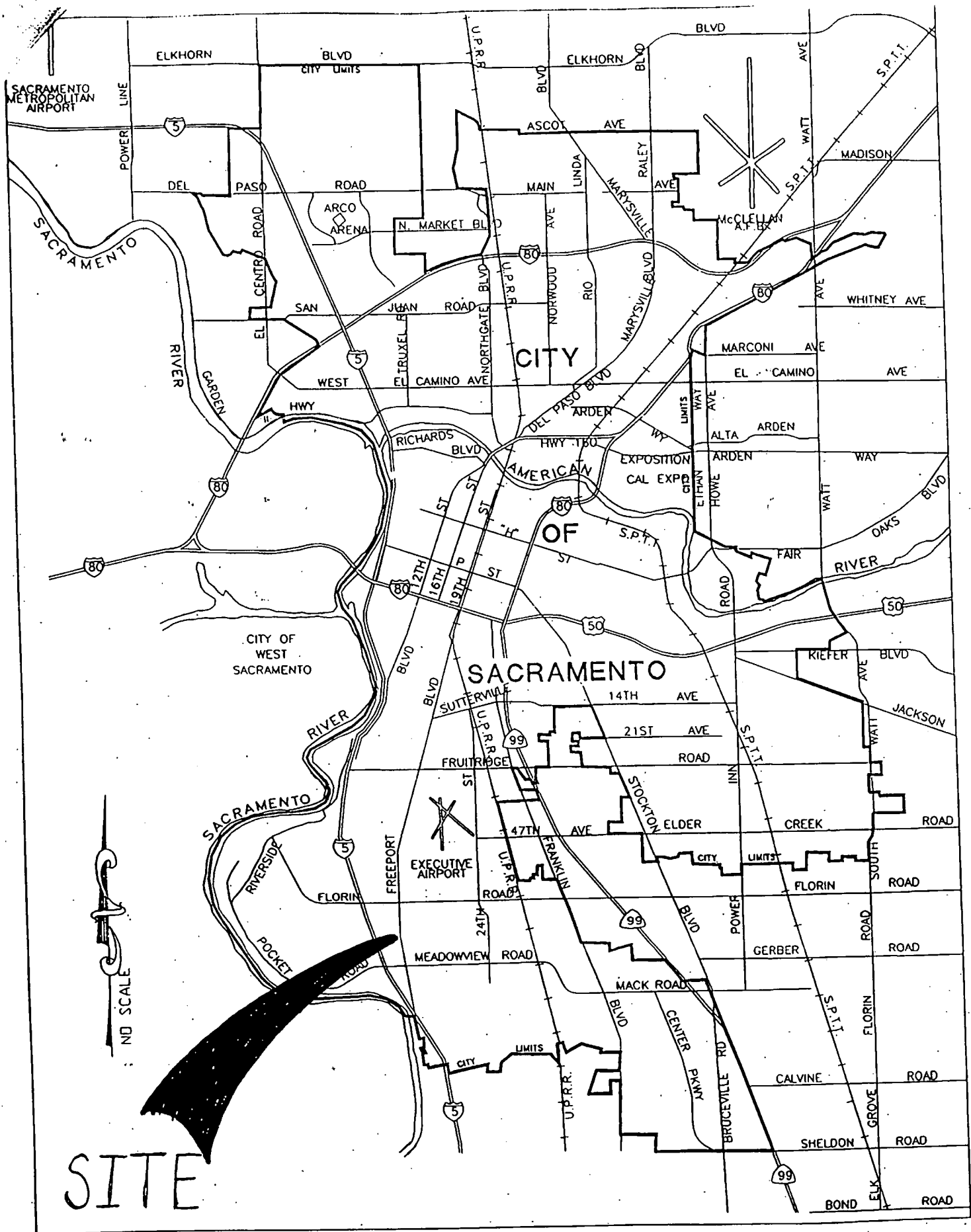
