Following the convening of the meeting and the reading of the call, the Council relinquished their seats on the rostrum to the members of the Transit Authority.


The Transit Authority, under the Chairmanship of E. Roy Higgins then convened and conducted a hearing on the proposal to increase bus fares.

Members of the City Council remained in session in the Chamber during said Transit Authority hearing and heard a statement from the Downtown Merchants Association and statements from eleven (11) citizens, all opposing the proposed increase of bus fares. Councilman Domich arrived during presentation of statements.


Councilman Marriott addressed the Authority expressing his opposition to the proposed increases.
