Broadway between 15th Street and 10th Street, Council District 4.

RECOMMENDATION:

This report recommends that the City Council:

- Approve the plans and specifications;
- Adopt the resolution approving a fund appropriation in the amount of \$162,570 to the Broadway Reconstruction (PN:TT31);
- Accept the bid of Granite Construction in the amount of \$1,050,050; and
- Authorize the City Manager to execute a contract for the Broadway Reconstruction (15th Street to 10th Street) (PN:TT31).

SUMMARY:

This project will reconstruct Broadway between 15th Street and 10th Street. Improvements include reconstruction of existing asphalt concrete, curb, gutter, and installation of a combined storm drainage and sewer system. Curb ramps will be reconstructed as required. The purpose of the project is to rehabilitate deteriorated streets, improve drainage, and improve the overall aesthetics in the area. Street lights will also be added to promote public safety.

COMMITTEE/COMMISSION ACTION:

None.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

- The project is authorized in the 1999/2000 Capital Improvements Program.
- The project is funded by Measure A (201) funds.
- This project was advertised and bids were received on March 9, 2000 and are summarized below:

- Granite Construction has met the ESBE goal and is the lowest responsive and responsible bidder.
- Contract award to Granite Construction is recommended.

FINANCIAL CONSIDERATIONS:

The engineer's estimated construction cost was \$1,194,040.

The estimated total project cost, including all planning, design, construction, and construction engineering costs is \$1,393,709. The current project budget is \$1,608,000. Additional funding appropriations in the amount of \$162,570 will be made to the project as follows:


POLICY CONSIDERATIONS:
