

ORDINANCE NO. 1012 , FOURTH SERIES.

AN ORDINANCE FIXING THE RATE OF SPECIAL TAX TO BE LEVIED AND LEVYING A SPECIAL TAX TO PROVIDE FOR THE SEMI-ANNUAL INTEREST ACCRUING JULY 1, 1944, AND JANUARY 1, 1945, UPON BONDS ISSUED PRIOR TO NOVEMBER 8, 1910, AND DESIGNATED AND KNOWN AS "OLD BONDS," TO PROVIDE FOR THE REDEMPTION OF SUCH BONDS AS MAY COME DUE AND PAYABLE ON JULY 1, 1944, AND JANUARY 1, 1945.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:


SECTION 1: The rate of .01 on each one hundred dollars (\$100.00) worth of taxable property within the old boundaries of the City of Sacramento is hereby fixed and established as the rate of a special tax to be levied for the purpose of providing for the payment during the fiscal year 1944-45 and the semi-annual interest accruing July 1, 1944, and January 1, 1945, upon those bonds issued prior to November 8, 1910, and designated and known as "Old Bonds," and the said rate of .01 on each one hundred dollars (\$100.00) worth of taxable property within the old boundaries of the City of Sacramento is hereby levied as a special tax for the purpose aforesaid.


