RESOLUTION ACCEPTING RIGHT-OF-WAY DEED

WHEREAS, LOUIS D. CARLSON, and ADA H. CARLSON, his wife, and JOHN SANDBURG and MINNIE E. SANDBURG, his wife

have made, executed and delivered to the City of Sacramento a certain **RIGHT-OF-WAY** Deed, conveying to the City of Sacramento the following real property in the City of Sacramento, County of Sacramento, State of California, bounded and particularly described as follows: in and upon a strip of land ten feet (10.0) feet in width, the description of which is as follows:

Beginning at a point from which the most westerly corner of Lot 125, as said lot is shown and so designated on the official plat of "River Park", filed in the office of the Recorder of Sacramento County in Book 23 of Maps, Map No. 41, bears South 51° 31' 30" East 35.00 feet; thence from said point of beginning South 38° 28' 30" West 987.00 feet; thence North 51° 31' 30" West 405.00 feet; thence North 45° 49' 30" West 400.00 feet; and thence South 69° 20' 30" West 109.41 feet to a point on the northeasterly boundary line of property of Central Pacific Railway Company.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

That the said **Right-of-Way** Deed be, and the same is, hereby accepted; the City Clerk being directed to attach certified copy hereof to the said **Right-of-Way** Deed, and record same in the office of the Sacramento County Recorder.
