The matter of the budget for the Civil Service Department for the year 1930 was next given consideration, and a figure of \$4316.50 was decided upon as the approximate amount necessary to carry on the activities of this department for the fiscal year 1930. The Secretary was instructed to prepare this budget in detail and forward to the City Manager.

There being no further business, adjournment was taken at 8:20 o'clock P.M. to meet again July 5, 1929, at 7:00 o'clock P.M.
