REPORT BACK ON ALTERNATIVE SHELTER CONCEPTS FOR THE HOMLESS ALONG THE AMERICAN RIVER PARKWAY

WHEREAS, the Redevelopment Agency of the City of Sacramento wishes to provide assistance in solving the problem of homelessness; and,

WHEREAS, the permanent camping of large populations of homeless persons in the American River Parkway and along the Sacramento River is found to constitute an emergency situation in that this is an unsafe, unsanitary and generally unhealthful situation; and,

WHEREAS, the Agency wishes to assist in removal of homeless campers from that area, and provide a humane, alternative place of shelter for them,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

Section 1: The sum of \$375,000 is hereby allocated from Downtown Tax Increment Funds for use according to the budget outlined below:

a) National Guard Armory and
Outdoor Day Program
(three to four months) \$134,000

or:

b) The "Trustee" Area -
(modification and
operations - three to
four months) \$200,000

or:

c) Short Term Sleep-Out Area
(setup and operations -
three to four months) \$139,000

and:

d) and Modular Lease/
Construction \$50,000

and:

e) Modular Operations \$50,000

and:

f) Expansion of SHARE Program \$50,000

and:

g) Agency Staff (Jul.-Dec. 89) \$25,000

TOTAL COSTS a,d,e,f,g \$309,000
or: b,d,e,f,g \$375,000
or: c,d,e,f,g \$314,000

Section 2. The Agency budget is hereby amended to reflect the following transfers:

First \$289,000 from the Northeast Neighborhood Housing Account; and, if necessary,

Second \$86,000 for the Detox program account.
