SUBJECT: Swimming Pool Agreement - Sacramento Job Corps Center

SUMMARY

This report recommends that the City enter into an agreement with Sacramento Job Corps Center for the use of their swimming pool for the 1988 summer season.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

The City has conducted a recreational swim program at the Sacramento Job Corps Center and has had an agreement with the Center since 1979. This service is an essential part of this Department's summer recreation program.

The Department of Parks and Community Services wishes to enter into an agreement for the 1988 summer season (June 20th through August 26, 1988) for the facility for recreational purposes to the benefit of the public.

Significant terms of the agreement include:

- Schedule of use
- One-year agreement
- City appoints and pays for personnel
- City is entitled to retain entrance fees to the pool
- Agreement may be terminated upon ten (10) days notice by either party

FINANCIAL DATA

The operational cost for the 1987 season was approximately \$6,500. The 1988 season cost is expected to be \$6,750 and has been included in the proposed FY 1988-89 Recreation Division operating budget.

RECOMMENDATION


