SUBJECT: APPROVAL OF PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS ACCEPTANCE OF BID
AND CONTRACT AWARD FOR 6TH AND I STREETS RECONSTRUCTION
PROJECT (PN:TK74)

LOCATION AND COUNCIL DISTRICT:

6th Street between H and I Streets and I Street between 5th and 6th Streets. District #1.

RECOMMENDATION:

This report recommends that the City Council:

- Approve the plans and specifications;
- Accept the low bid of R.C. Collet, Inc. in the amount of \$222,170; and
- Authorize the City Manager to execute a contract for the 6th and I Streets Reconstruction Project (PN:TK74).

SUMMARY:

This project is the first phase of street improvements around the new Federal Courthouse. This project will reconstruct 6th Street between H and I Streets and replace the existing curb and gutter on I Street between 5th and 6th Street. These improvements are required to repair damage to 6th and I streets that has occurred during courthouse construction. The City is seeking reimbursement from the Federal Government.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

- This project was authorized in the 1996/1997 Capital Improvement Program.
- This project was advertised and bids were received on July 30, 1997 and are summarized below:

R.C. Collet, Inc.	\$222,170	18.90%	16.45%	N/A

- The construction estimate is \$184,500.
- R.C. Collet, Inc. did meet the MBE/WBE goals and received a goal preference credit of \$11,108.50 which makes them the lowest responsible bidder.
- Approval of the plans and specifications and award to R.C. Collet, Inc. is recommended.

FINANCIAL CONSIDERATIONS:

- The estimated total project cost, including all planning, design and construction and construction engineering costs, is \$348,410.
- The unobligated funds, 248/202, balance for this project, as of August 6, 1997, is \$472,410, which is sufficient for award.

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ENVIRONMENTAL CONSIDERATIONS:

The Planning Services Division, Environmental Section has reviewed the project and has determined that this project is exempt from the CEQA under Section 15301 (c) of the CEQA Guidelines. A notice of categorical exemption will be filed, after Council approval of the project.


POLICY CONSIDERATIONS:

MBE/WBE:


To encourage minority participation, plans and specifications were sent to 9 plan rooms and construction services organization for publication. Four are directly involved with MBE/WBE construction firms. Staff actively recruited available MBE/WBE firms to participate in the bid process. The project was also announced on the Project Information Line and on the City's Internet site at www.sacto.org/bids. Project notices were sent to 30 organizations involved in MBE/WBE recruitment.
