A RESOLUTION APPROVING AGREEMENT BETWEEN CITY OF SACRAMENTO, COUNTY OF SACRAMENTO, AND STATIONARY ENGINEERS, LOCAL 39, INTERNATIONAL UNION OF OPERATING ENGINEERS, AFL-CIO, REGARDING THE LABOR-MANAGEMENT NEGOTIATING PROCESS ON THE MERGER OF CITY-COUNTY SOLID WASTE AND GARDEN REFUSE OPERATIONS

WHEREAS, the Sacramento City Council and the Sacramento Board of Supervisors have taken recent actions to approve in concept the merger of the City-County Solid Waste and Garden Refuse Operations in order to integrate services and transition employees to a single employer; and

WHEREAS, Stationary Engineers, Local 39, International Union of Operating Engineers, AFL-CIO, the recognized employee organization for employees in the representation units in the City and County covering most employees in Solid Waste and Garden Refuse Operations, has expressed a concern over the waiver of bargaining rights during the transition process; and

WHEREAS, representatives of the City, County, and Local 39 arrived at a tentative agreement on the negotiating process to assure Local 39 that a merger will not become effective until an agreement is reached by the parties; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that the provisions of the tentative agreement are fair and proper and in the best interests of the City of Sacramento;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO, that it adopt in full the terms and conditions contained in the said Agreement.
