SUBJECT: REQUEST FOR RESOLUTION APPROVING EXECUTION OF CONTRACT
REFLECTING SALARY INCREASE FOR MOUNTAIN-VALLEY LIBRARY
SYSTEM EMPLOYEE VIRGINIA SHORT.

SUMMARY:

The City-County Librarian requests approval by the City Council of the execution of agreement between the City of Sacramento acting on behalf of the Mountain-Valley Library System, and Virginia Short, currently providing services to the Mountain-Valley Library System, said agreement reflecting salary increase granted by the MVLS Executive Council for Fiscal Year 1981/82.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

The Mountain-Valley Library System (MVLS) is a consortium of independent city, county, college, university and special libraries who have joined to form a cooperative network, providing interlibrary loans, reference backup and delivery services for a nine-county area in the state of California.

Following intensive review and comparison of like positions within the salary structure of the City of Sacramento, the agreement has been prepared, reviewed and approved by the Executive Council of the Mountain-Valley Library System (May 14, 1981) and subsequently approved by the California State Library under Library Services and Construction Act grant award for Fiscal Year 1981/82.

FINANCIAL DATA:

The City of Sacramento, as fiscal agent for the Mountain-Valley Library System, expends MVLS funds received pursuant to standard agreements between the State Department of Education, the State Library and the City of Sacramento; there is no obligation on the part of the City of Sacramento or MVLS to continue personnel employed with project funds after these funds have been expended. This MVLS employee is not in any jurisdiction's civil service system. As the contract stipulates, this employee is not an employee of either the City of Sacramento, or the individual participating libraries in the cooperative library system.



Also, as stipulated in the contract, the System, from System funds, pays social security, workers' compensation and medical and dental benefits. No retirement benefit is offered to Mountain Valley Library System employees, other than Social Security. No City funds are used for any payment to any Mountain Valley Library System employee; the System pays the entire cost from its funds. The System also pays a fiscal agent fee to the City (\$12,205 in FY 80/81) to enable the City to recover the costs of expending Mountain Valley Library System funds.

RECOMMENDATION:


