

## **RESOLUTION NO. 2006-694**

Adopted by the Sacramento City Council

September 19, 2006

### **APPROVING THE TIME EXTENSION FOR RESOLUTION NO. 2003-682, WITHIN COUNCIL DISTRICT 1 VACATION PROCEEDING NO. VP06-09**

#### **BACKGROUND**

- A. With the adoption of Resolution No. 2003-682 on September 30, 2003, the abandonment of North "B" Street between 17th Street and 18th Street, "A" Street between 16th Street and 18th Street, 18th Street between North "B" Street and "B" Street, and the alleys bounded by North "B" Street, "A" Street, 16th Street and 18th Street within Council District 1, the City Council may grant a time extension for the completion of conditions of vacation specified in the said resolution of vacation.
- B. On September 27, 2005, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 2005-702 extending the time to complete the conditions required by Resolution No. 2003-682 for one year. All conditions were to be completed by September 30, 2006.
- C. The California Almond Growers Exchange requests an additional one year extension to complete the conditions of abandonment stated in Resolution No. 2003-682.

#### **BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1. The time extension for completing the conditions of vacation required by Resolution No. 2003-682 is hereby extended from September 30, 2006 to September 30, 2007.
