ORDINANCE NO. 85-102

ADOPTED BY THE SACRAMENTO CITY COUNCIL ON DATE OF

ORDINANCE INCREASING FROM NINE TO ELEVEN THE MEMBERSHIP ON THE SACRAMENTO TOXIC SUBSTANCES COMMISSION, AND DECLARING THE ORDINANCE TO BE AN EMERGENCY MEASURE TO TAKE EFFECT IMMEDIATELY

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Section 2.343 of the Sacramento City Code is hereby amended to read:

Sec. 2.343 Appointment of Members; Terms of Office; Qualifications; Compensation

(a) The Commission shall consist of eleven members appointed by the Mayor, subject to the concurrence of the City Council. All members shall serve a term of two years, commencing on the date the Commission holds its first regular meeting. The appointments shall be subject to the appointment procedures of Sections 2.126-30 through 2.126-37 of the City Code applicable to Boards and Commissions.

(b) At least seven members shall have special knowledge or experience in one or more areas pertinent to the handling, clean-up or abatement of toxic substances. This special knowledge or experience may be obtained by way of training, professional or non-professional personal experience, or academic education.

(c) Commission members shall be compensated in the same manner as members of the Sacramento City Planning Commission.

SECTION 2. EMERGENCY. This ordinance is declared to be an emergency ordinance to take effect immediately. The facts constituting the urgency are: The public interest will best be served by increasing the membership on the Toxic Substances Commission from nine to eleven members. In order that the eleven-member Commission may begin its work at the earliest time possible, it is necessary that this ordinance take effect immediately.
