SUMMARY

This report recommends approval of project plans for improvements to the McKinley Park picnic area (FY 1981-82 CIP Project No. G-12.5).

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

In August of 1981, the City Council accelerated the McKinley Park picnic area improvements project from FY 1984-85 to FY 1981-82 to alleviate problems resulting from heavy park use. Two factors have contributed to the declining condition of the picnic area:

1. Heavy foot traffic in picnic area resulting from heavy park use.
2. Vehicle damage to turf and picnic area.

The fiscal year 1981-82 Capital Improvement Program includes \$40,000 to provide improvements to the McKinley Park picnic area and access. By Resolution No. 81-693, the City Council directed that funds shall not be expended until the Council approves the project design.

Staff has identified the following measures to improve the condition of the picnic area:

1. Addition of vertical curbs to block vehicle access to the turf area.
2. Installation of decomposed granite surfacing to the picnic area.
3. General improvements to the picnic area such as installation of a large barbecue for group use and electrical outlets.

Additionally, the installation of a concrete pad near the tennis courts, and a concrete walkway between the tennis courts and the restroom, valued at approximately \$10,000, have been donated by the Community Tennis Improvements Association at no cost to the City.

Exhibit A attached provides a schematic drawing of the proposed improvements.

FINANCIAL DATA

The FY 1981-82 Department of Community Services CIP budget includes \$40,000 in Park Development Funds for the McKinley Park project. No additional funding is required.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the City Council approve, by resolution, the proposed design for improvements to the McKinley Park picnic area and access.
