Adopted by The Sacramento City Council on date of

March 3, 1934


WHEREAS, Project S-3 concerning the removal of parking stripes in certain streets was, by the City of Sacramento, duly submitted to the Federal Civil Works Administration and by it approved, and work on same commenced by said C.W.A. and the Federal Government, and,

WHEREAS, certain protests were made by adjacent property owners, and


WHEREAS, said C.W.A. wishes an agreement of indemnity or hold-harmless agreement to and for the benefit of the Federal Government, the Federal Civil Works Administration and its officers and employees as a condition of continuing the work,

NOW, THEREFORE, the Mayor and City Clerk, for and on behalf of the City of Sacramento, are hereby authorized and directed to make, execute and deliver such agreement.
