

# RESOLUTION NO. 2004-611

ADOPTED BY THE SACRAMENTO CITY COUNCIL  
ON DATE OF JUL 27 2004

## RESOLUTION APPROVING

**WHEREAS;** the City Manager and Fire Department management have taken allegations of possible misconduct and/or criminal behavior by firefighters on July 2, 2004 very seriously;


**WHEREAS;** the City Manager and Fire Department seek to take proactive steps to make positive differences within the Department for the future; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO THAT:**

- Receive and file the summaries of the investigations and the action plan prepared by Fire Chief Julius Cherry related to recent alleged violations of Fire Department policies;
- Direct the City Manager to appoint a taskforce to conduct a systems review of Fire Department management, accountability, and command and control operations, and report back on actions taken to the City Manager's Office within 120 days;
- Expand the responsibilities of the current Office of Police Accountability to include the Fire Department, and rename the Office of Police Accountability to the Office of Public Safety Accountability to more accurately reflect its expanded scope of responsibilities;
- Approve the protocol for engaging the Office of Public Safety Accountability; and
- Report back to the Mayor and City Council within 120 days on the establishment of an Office of Internal Affairs and Professional Standards within the Sacramento Fire Department.
