SUBJECT: Amend CIP By Establishing the G, H, 25th and 26th Streets Alley Assessment District No. 88-

01; Amend the 1989/90 Revenue Budget and Appropriate Funds (JN:1236)

#### SUMMARY

It is requested that the Budget and Finance Committee recommend approval of the attached resolution to establish the project, amend the Revenue Budget and appropriate funds for the 1989/90 Budget. This funding will allow the Department of Public Works to construct various improvements (e.g., sewer, water drainage, pavement, etc.) in the G, H, 25th and 26th Streets Alley Assessment District No. 88-01 (23AD).

#### **BACKGROUND**

The public hearing on October 10, 1989, was closed and Council voted to approve the G, H, 25th and 26th Streets Alley Assessment District No. 88-01 (23AD) and adopt the Amended Engineer's Report. The assessment was recorded on October 13, 1989.

The project will provide the construction of a Portland Cement concrete paved alleyway with drainage facilities, together with all necessary appurtenances. The alley is bounded by G Street on the north, H Street on the south, 25th Street on the west and 26th Street on the east. The exact boundaries are shown on the attachment.

#### **FINANCIAL DATA**

The funds necessary for this project are forthcoming from the possible payoffs of any assessment during the 30-day cash collection period and proceeds from the sale of the bonds on the unpaid assessments. The attached resolution will amend the 1989/90 Capital Improvement Budget by establishing the G, H, 25th and 26th Streets Alley Assessment District No. 88-01 (23AD), increase the Revenue Budget and appropriate the funds. A summary of the project costs based on contract costs are as follows:

RESOLUTION AMENDING AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS FOR THE FY 1989/90 CITY CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM BUDGET FOR G, H, 25TH AND 26TH STREETS ALLEY ASSESSMENT DISTRICT NO. 88-01 (23AD)

### BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

- 1. The City Capital Improvement Program is hereby amended by establishing the project known as G, H, 25th and 26th Streets Alley Assessment District No.88-01 (23AD).
- 2. The following appropriation increase is to be supported by revenue that is forthcoming from the payment of the assessment by the property owners during the 30 day collection period and from sale of bonds to be issued on all unpaid assessments and by a City Contribution from the existing 1989/90 Miscellaneous Sewer Replacement XC41. The 1989/90 Revenue Budget is hereby amended by increasing fund 660-ASD-23AD-3712 for G, H, 25th and 26th Streets Alley Assessment District by the amount \$70,700.63 (\$73,646.49, the amount charged to property owners, minus \$2,945.86).
- The City Capital Improvement Program budget is hereby amended by appropriating \$70,700.63, supported by revenue to be received, and transferring \$59,878.35 in the Miscellaneous Sewer Replacement (414-500-XC41-4820) to 414-ASD-23AD-4820 for G, H, 25th and 26th Streets Alley Assessment District 88-01.

These transfers will provide sufficient funds to pay the contractor, Cord Construction progress payments for work to be performed, construction of G, H, 25th and 26th Streets Alley Assessment District 88-01 and to pay all incidental expenses associated with said assessment district.

4. The Director of Finance is hereby authorized and directed to expend the total sum of \$130,578.98. The amount of \$85,800.00, is to be paid to Cord Construction to construct improvements in the H, 25th and 26th Streets Alley Assessment District No. 88-01. The balance of \$44,778.98 will be paid as follows: \$6,006.00 in Contingency to cover any cost overruns and \$38,772.98, to pay the engineering and other incidental expenses charged to the assessment district.
