SUBJECT: Amendments to the City of Sacramento Community  
Development Block Grant (CDBG) Program - Public Hearing

**SUMMARY**

The attached resolutions (1) reallocate surplus funds from completed projects to 1987 contingency; (2) allocate to 1987 contingency an additional amount for funds restored to the City because Congress did not adopt the proposed rescission of 1987 CDBG funds; (3) transfer funds from 1987 contingency to current projects as additional financing; and (4) transfer funds from 1987 contingency to a new project, East Del Paso Heights Street Improvements 5B.

(Federal regulations require a public hearing for consideration of the new project.)

**BACKGROUND**

Periodically, the CDBG budget is amended to move surplus funds from completed projects to active ones to ensure that active projects are fully funded to their completion and to new projects which fill a locally identified need. Also, additional monies have now become available because Congress did not approve the

Administration's 16 percent rescission of 1987 CDBG funds. This results in an additional \$455,000 for the 1987 CDBG program. Another \$1,000 has been added from reallocation of a national pool of FY 1985 CDBG funds. This increase permits the program to fund construction of East Del Paso Heights Street Improvements Phase 5B, to finance projects needing additional funds, and to maintain a minimum contingency budget.

Chart A, attached, shows the reprogramming actions proposed by this report. Highlights of significant changes are discussed briefly below:

## A. Project Requiring Additional Funds

1. McClellan School Tot Lot, Phase II - \$11,619.33 surplus from Phase I of the Tot Lot will be moved forward to Phase II. These funds will cover the cost of adding lights to the playground areas improved under both Phase I and Phase II. The lighting is needed for safety and security reasons.
2. Rehab Loans and Grants - An additional \$168,000 is needed to fund anticipated loan and retrofit grant applications. As you recall, the current rehabilitation loan fund is almost entirely committed to active and pending cases.

## B. New Programs

East Del Paso Heights 5B - \$522,000 is needed for this project. This project was listed in the 1987 Application for highest priority if additional funds became available. This is a full street improvement project in the area shown on Exhibit A which includes curbs, gutters, sidewalks, and street lights; it was fully designed with 1985 funds and has received environmental review.

## C. Potential New Project

Another potential new project is being developed by staff which would assist in the construction of an 80-unit apartment complex to house low-income tenants through the CHFA Minority Developer Program. Should this project materialize, it is essential that adequate contingency be available to fund this project at approximately \$100,000. If and when plans for this project are finalized, staff will schedule a public hearing for City Council consideration of project funding.

## FINANCIAL DATA

These proposed reprogrammings are necessary to keep existing projects adequately financed and to transfer surplus funds from completed projects to cover future contingencies and additional projects which need to be funded.

After approval of this report, the 1987 CDBG contingency balance will be increased from \$149,298.14 to \$184,483.88.

## ENVIRONMENTAL REVIEW

All of the projects listed in attached Chart A have previously received environmental review under both the California Environmental Quality Act and the National Environmental Protection Act.

## POLICY IMPLICATIONS

The actions proposed in this staff report are consistent with previously approved policy. These proposed reprogrammings ensure appropriate budgets for activities previously approved by the Council.

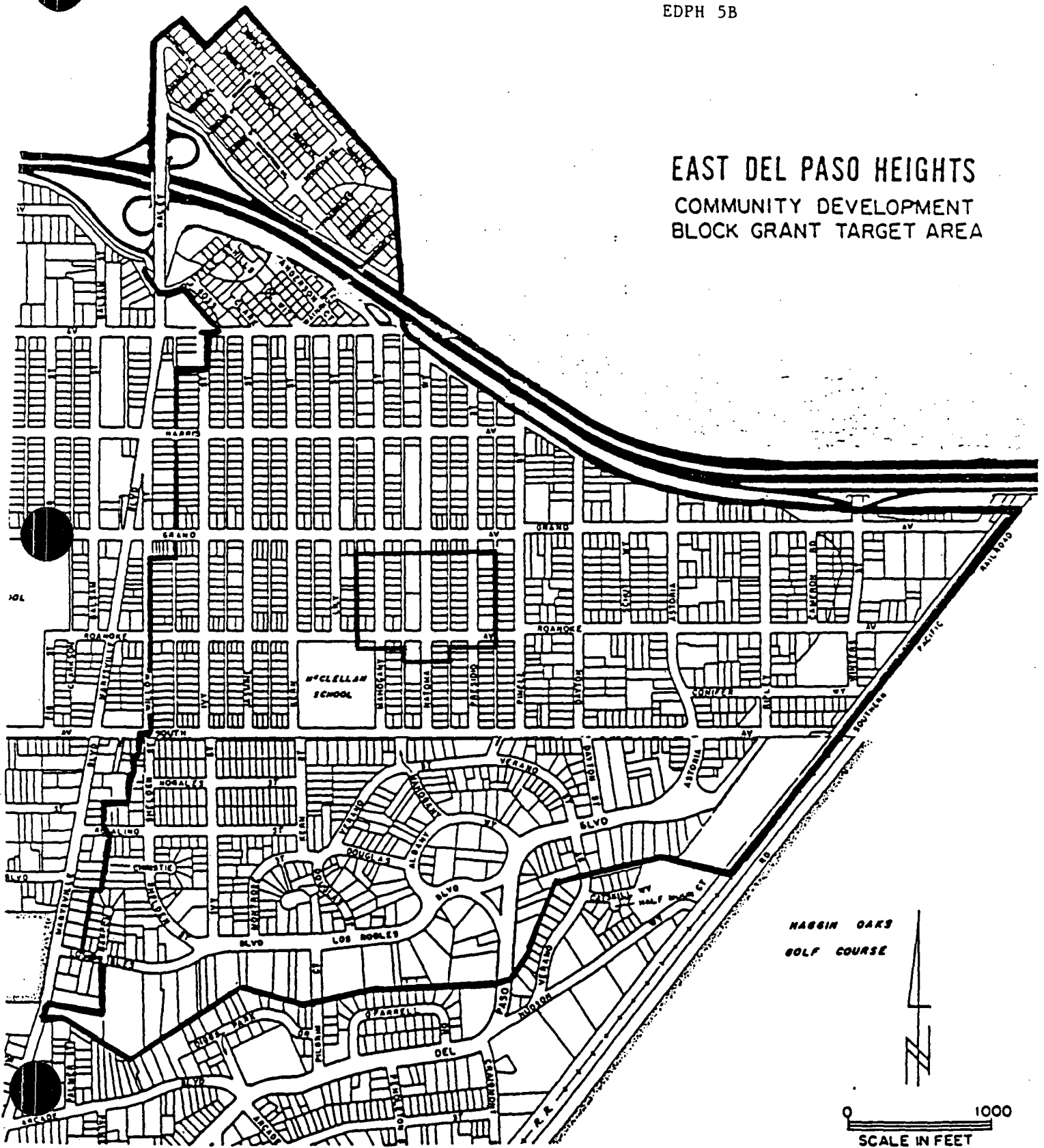
