MINUTES OF SPECIAL MEETING  
HONORABLE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO  
JANUARY 2nd, 1926.

1 Pursuant to Call issued by Councilmen Anderson and John H. Miller, the Honorable City Council met in Special Session on this date at hour of 11:15 o'clock A. M.,

Councilman Kiernan moved that Councilman Anderson be appointed Chairman Pro Tem. Seconded by Councilman John H. Miller and thereupon Councilman Anderson assumed the Chair and Roll Call was answered by following members of the City Council:

Councilmen Anderson, Bellhouse, Conley, Elliott, Goddard, Kiernan, John H. Miller, Royal Miller. ABSENT: Councilman Bidwell.

Call for the Meeting, which stated purpose thereof to be the election of a Mayor of the City of Sacramento and President Pro Tem of the City Council, was read and ordered filed.

The Chairman announcing nominations for the office of Mayor in order, Councilman John H. Miller thereupon arose and nominated Councilman Goddard for such office, and stated that such nomination was made because of the ability and qualifications of Nominee for the office and not for the reason that the member so nominated had been honored with the highest vote at recent municipal election; nomination seconded by Councilman Royal Miller, who addressed Council, expressing himself to same effect.

Councilman Kiernan moved that nominations be closed. Seconded by Councilman John H. Miller.

Councilman Conley moved that nomination be made unanimous. Seconded by Councilman Royal Miller and carried by following vote:

AYES: Councilmen Anderson, Bellhouse, Conley, Elliott, Kiernan, John H. Miller, Royal Miller. ABSENT: Councilman Bidwell. NOT VOTING: Councilman Goddard, who addressed Council expressing his appreciation of the honor thus conferred and stated that he would strive to merit the confidence of the Council in fulfilling the duties of the office.

The Chair announcing nominations then in order for President Pro Tem of the City Council, Councilman Kiernan nominated Councilman John H. Miller for such office; Seconded by Councilman Elliott.

Councilman Royal Miller moved that nominations close. Seconded by Councilman Kiernan.

Councilman Conley moved that nomination be made unanimous. Seconded by Councilman Elliott and carried by following vote:

AYES: Councilmen Anderson, Bellhouse, Conley, Elliott, Kiernan, Royal Miller, Goddard. ABSENT: Councilman Bidwell. NOT VOTING Councilman John H. Miller, who also addressed Council, returning his thanks for the honor conferred upon him, and said he would do all in his power during the ensuing term to carry out and perform the work of his office to the credit of the City Council and the City of Sacramento.

The Chair declared the purpose of the meeting completed and urged all mem-
